1 In advance Please call us to reserve your ferry Only evening ferries are available before your seat.

Please call "MOL SUNFLOWER Passenger Reservation Center" to book your seat.

*You cannot book over the Internet.
*Reservations open at 9:00 a.m. on the same date, two months prior. If that date falls on a Sunday, holiday, Dec. 31-Jan. 4, or May 1st, reservations open on the next business day.
*Please be sure to inform the Passenger Reservations Center staff that you have made a "Pacific Story" reservation.
*If you would like to upgrade to a higher class when you reserve your seat, please specify the class you prefer. Please pay the upgrade fee at the ferry terminal counter on the day of boarding.
*You can pay for your package ticket at any bus company's Ticket Center (Bus seat reservations are not accepted).

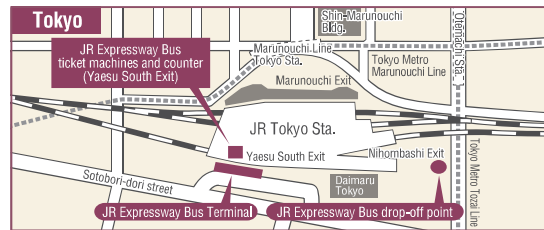

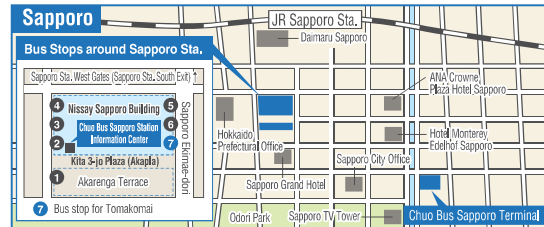
Please purchase tickets for Pacific Story at the Ticket Center of the specified bus companies.

*Please purchase your package ticket well in advance of boarding as the counter may be busy and you may miss the bus.



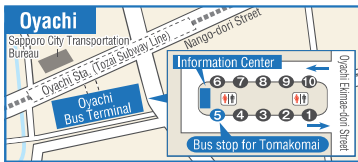
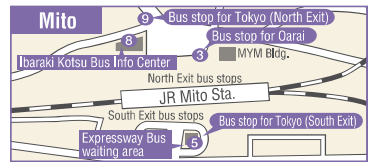

Tokyo-Sapporo "Pacific Story" are special package tickets, connecting Tokyo and popular tourist attractions in Sapporo via comfortable ferries and expressway buses.



Basic Itinerary

•Tokyo Station-Port of Oarai and Port of Tomakomai-Sapporo tickets are valid for 2 days (until the day before boarding and the day of boarding, the day before going ashore and the day of going ashore).
It's easy to customize your trip and arrange the schedule that's right for you. For example, you can add overnight stays in Mito and Oarai, or Tomakomai.

*Local accommodation charges are not included.
*Each ticket is not valid for stopovers.
*Not available when ferries are out of service.

Notes

•Any buses with departure times later than those specified in the basic itinerary below do not connect with the scheduled ferries.
•Connections may not be possible due to traffic, weather, or sea conditions. In such cases, we will make our best efforts to ensure seat availability on a subsequent bus or ferry. 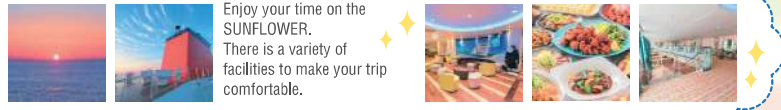

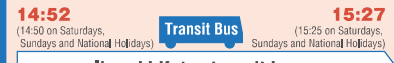

Refunds

Only unused package tickets are eligible for refund at the purchase counter (cancellation fees applied as specified below).
Only discount package tickets sold at the following bus company counters will be accepted (a service fee will also be applied when changing the reservation time after ticket issuance).
•Refund fee: 500 yen
*Tickets are only eligible for refund prior to the departure time on the day of departure.
*Partial refunds will be granted only for delays caused by unforeseeable circumstances.
